

Ambassador Luis Gallegos has served as a diplomat for more than 50 years, out of which 30 have been within the UN. Among his many achievements stands Chairman of the International Convention on the human rights of the persons with disabilities. He is also a Special Advisor and ex-member of the International Board of Special Olympics. He is Senior Advisor of the Disability Project of the Harvard Law School. He currently serves as President of the Board of Directors of UNITAR and Chairman of the Global initiative on Ageing & Longevity (GIA Longevity), among many other institutions.
